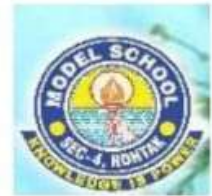
Our Envisionary

Our Endeavour :

The role of a school has always been most crucial. Model school sec-4 provides quality education that would endure the test of time. It is a nursery where students learn to live the rest of their lives in peaceful co - existence with the surroundings.

Our Credo :

Faculty :

Academic Calender :

The New Session commences from 2nd April every year. The academic calender has been divided into two terms for all the classes. A comprehensive scheme of examination has been drawn up for the continuous and comprehensive evaluation of the pupils.

Infrastructure :

The school comprises of a modern building housing its administrative office and well ventilated spacious classrooms. This is the only school where every class room is equipped with SMART CLASS FACILITY which makes learning an enlightening experience and a perpetual process. There is a Central Library, Music Room, Visitor's Room, Laboratories for Science, Mathematics, Computer Science, a Server Room, a School Clinic and a School Canteen.

Admission :

New admissions are made from Nursery to Class XII. Registration is mandatory online. **Model School has initiated digitalisation of it's functioning through online portal. The parents can visit our website for any information they want to enquire about.** However, registration does not guarantee admission.

For admission to class Nursery, the age of the child should be between 3 to 4 years on 31st March of the year. Registration for Nursery is usually done in the month of January / February. At the time of admission to Nursery, the original date of birth certificate issued by the Municipal Committee must be submitted, without which admission will not be granted.

Medical Certificate showing a true and detailed picture of the child's health should also be duly filled up and submitted at the time of admission. It is in the interest of the child and as well as the school.

SUMMER UNIFORM (April to October)

BOYS :

1. White Shirt with school insignia on pocket.
2. Prescribed Blue Pant/Shorts.
3. Grey Socks with Blue Stripes on top.
4. Black Leather Shoes with laces.
5. School Belt.
6. Turban or Patka of Sky Blue Colour for Sikh Boys .
7. White Shorts/Trousers.

GIRLS

1. White Shirt/Blouse with school insignia on pocket.
2. Prescribed Blue Skirt/Tunic.
3. Grey Socks/Stockings with Blue Stripes on top.
4. Black Leather Shoes.
5. School Belt.

WINTER UNIFORM (November to March)

BOYS :

1. White full sleeves Shirt with school insignia on pocket.
2. Steel grey woollen pant.
3. Nave Blue Blazer with School insignia on the pocket. Pullover with sky blue stripes on borders and V neck.
4. Grey woollen socks with blue stripes on top.
5. School Belt & Tie.
6. Turban or Patka of Navy Blue Colour for Sikh Boys.

GIRLS:

1. White full sleeves Shirt/Blouse.
2. Steel grey woollen Skirt.
3. Grey leggings allowed for girls upto class II
4. Navy Blue blazer with school insignia on the pocket. Pullover with sky blue stripes on borders and V neck. Blue Stripes on top.
5. Grey woollen Socks/Stockings with Blue stripes on top.
6. Black Leather Shoes.
7. School Belt and Tie.

Note :-

- a) White dress on Saturdays.
- b) Girls upto class II are to wear 'Tunics'.
- c) Boys upto class II are to wear shorts with straps. From class III onwards girls will wear divided skirts. Boys from class II onwards, upto class VIII will wear shorts only in summers.
- d) Boys should have proper and regular hair cut.
- e) Wearing of canvas shoes of any colour is NOT allowed.
- f) Students are required to wear white lab. Coats during practical work.
- g) Use of trousers for girls is strictly prohibited.
- h) Improperly dressed children will not be allowed to enter the school.
- i) Use of mobile phones is strictly prohibited in the campus. Fine of Rs. 500 will be charged from the defaulter.

Admission Policy

Admission to Classes-Nursery to XII

- Fresh admissions are made in Nursery and XI classes only. Admission to other classes is subject to the availability of vacancies. Registration is a must for admission to any class. However, registration does not guarantee admission.
- For admission to Nursery Class, age of the child should be between 3 to 4 years as on 31st March of that year. Registration for Nursery is usually done in the month of January. Admission is granted on the first come first serve basis. At the time of admission, the original date of birth certificate issued by the Municipal Committee must be submitted, otherwise admission will not be granted.
- Medical proforma showing a true and detailed picture of the child's health should also be duly filled in and submitted at the time of admission. It is in the interest of the child as well as the school.

Admission in Class XI

Admission in Class XI will be carried out in two phases. Initially the students will be registered for admission by charging amount equivalent to two months' tuition fee. This amount will be adjusted against their fee while seeking permanent admission after declaration of X class result. However, this amount will stand forfeited for students who do not seek permanent admission under any circumstances. Regular classes (Bridge Course) will commence 10 days after the last Board/Home paper of Class X.

Students from other schools

Students coming from other schools affiliated to CBSE can be granted admission provided seats are available and they have minimum A2 grading in Science, Mathematics and overall. Students coming from Boards other than CBSE, will generally not be granted admission in class XI, however, extraordinary meritorious students may be considered.

Allotment of streams

We have four streams in classes XI & XII i.e. Science (Non-Medical), Science (Medical), Commerce with and without Mathematics and Humanities. Criteria for allotment of streams, based on final marks obtained in class X :-

Note :

1. At the time of registration, marks of Pre-Board exam or where Pre-Board is not conducted then marks of FA1, FA2, FA3, FA4 & SA1 put together will be taken into account for allotment of streams. Students can take up stream of their choice only by giving an undertaking until the X class final results. Then after cognisance of undertaking will be taken. However, the CBSE latest policy will not be compromised.
2. Change of stream/subject after registration with CBSE in Class XI will not be permitted.

Admission Procedure

- Admission will be allowed only after a student submits the T.C. of the previous school alongwith the original date of birth proof for classes I to VIII.
- For admission to classes IX a written test will be conducted in subjects - English, Hindi, Maths, General Science and S. Studies.
- Meritorious students securing CGPA-10 in class X can be admitted in class XI irrespective of their priority category and strength of the class/sections.
- Outstanding sports persons who are position holders at State/National/International level can be admitted, if seats are available in that class.
- Priority in admission will be given to transfer cases of Haryana/Central Government employees only. However, these will be within the laid down limits.
- Admissions to classes X & XII will not be granted except for parents transfer cases, that too subject to availability of vacancies and approval by CBSE.
- Latest Govt. Policy on RTE/134A etc. will be followed.
- Number of seats will be restricted to a max of 40 students in every section.

Policy & Award of Scholarships/Concessions/Grants etc.

SPORTS

- Full concession for one year to National/International position holders except conveyance charges. In addition, Scholarship of Rs. 1000/-p.m. for entire period of stay in the school since the time of achievement to the international position holders.
- Full concession except Annual charges/conveyance charges for one year to State I position holders and full tuition fee concession for II & III position holders.
- CBSE/Haryana State Schools/National/Zonal tournaments (recognized only)
 - I Position : Full Tuition fee concession for 1 year
 - II Position : 1/2 Tuition fee concession for 1 year
 - III Position : 1/4 Tuition fee concession for 1 year
- Best athlete of the year boy/girl : Half tuition fee concession for one year to both.

Co-Curricular Activities (CC As)

Same as for sports. However, CBSE recognized CC As only are eligible.

Academics :

- Class X :
 - AI grading = Cash award of Rs. 1100/-
- Class XII :
 - Top three students securing 95% Marks & above to get a gold plated, pure silver medal.
 - All subject toppers with min. 95% marks will be awarded Rs. 1100/-
 - IIT/Common Engg. Entrance exam up to top 5000 ranks, AIIMS, NTSE, National Position holders - Gold Planted Silver Medal.
 - AIPMT rank amongst first 1000, State, PMT (Haryana) rank upto first 50, CPT (CA) rank amongst first 10 at National Level and NDA (with approval of the chairman) will get pure silver medal at the time of Annual Day.

Note :

1. Candidates qualifying for more than one award will be awarded the higher/highest award only.
2. Sports discipline CC As approved by the CBSE only will qualify for the scholarships/award.
3. Achievements of the current year only will qualify for the scholarships / awards etc.
